## Calling on You

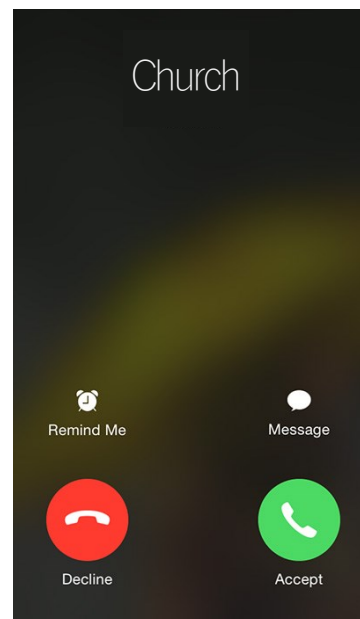
The Call Committee continues to meet on a frequent basis. We are working hard to finish our Ministry Site Profile (MSP), which will be submitted to the Synod once completed. Once the MSP is submitted, we may begin interviewing candidates.

While our Call Committee is able to fill out many parts of the MSP, we are asking for input from the larger congregation on certain topics. The full participation of CLC members with its variety of voices is essential to a successful call process. By drawing an accurate portrait of our faith community, and with the Holy Spirit's guidance, we will obtain a Senior Minister with the gifts to support and enhance our lives together as a congregation.

On Sunday, May 19, the Call Committee will be conducting a very important initiative to fill out our MSP. This will be done during the education hour (9:30-10:15 am). The congregation will be asked four to five questions as to who we are as a congregation, what our hopes are for the future, and what qualities we are looking for in our next Senior Minister. We will have focused conversations around each of the questions in small groups.

Your input is an important element of this process. This is "our Church" and we are "Calling on You" to help us complete the MSP. Please plan to join us on May 19 beginning at 9:30 am. Thank you for your continued support in this season of transition.

## Cantata *Mark your calendars: May 5*

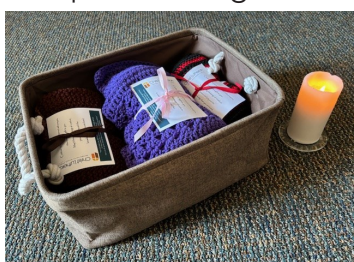
### BY GRACE ALONE - The Solas in Song and Word
