Synod Assembly Recap: Be Good Listeners

Brothers and Sisters—

Thank you for the opportunity to serve as voting delegates representing Christ Lutheran at the Northern Illinois Synod Assembly, June 13-14. It was a time of learning, of conducting synod business and of joining together to celebrate our shared ministries.

Bishop Stacie, the Synod staff, and Synod Council are a remarkable team and it showed in the time and energy that they dedicated to the assembly. From the opening pageantry, the powerful prayers offered up and hymns of praise to the harmonious resolution discussions and detailed synod agenda.

Two resolutions were passed by the assembly. Resolution 1—for National Day of Remembrance for Indian Boarding School, to be held annually on or near September 30th. The goal of this day is to broaden our awareness of our role in Indian Boarding Schools. Educational programs will be created for lay people and clergy. Resolution 2—for Northern Illinois Synod to be a Reconciling in Christ Synod. As a synod we will strive to welcome and embrace people of every race, national origin, immigration status, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, disability, health and mental health status or socio economic status.

Our keynote speaker, Deacon Jessica Noonan from LEAD Connects, challenged congregations to "listen to our neighbors" that live and work around our physical church buildings. It used to be that you would build a church and people would come. That's what we do—we go to church. Life has shifted. Today, we as disciples need to show up where people are, be proactive, and be good listeners to their spiritual needs.
