## Staff Shifts

As we head into another program year, no one could have imagined that we would still be without a settled senior minister over two and one half years after we bid Godspeed and farewell to Pastor Twila. We have been faithful to God and to one another during this interim period. We have been blessed to welcome several new members during this time, and our calendar continues to be filled with meetings and activities — signs of a healthy, thriving faith community.

This time has not been easy, especially for the staff.

As we transition into yet another fall, there are some staff shifts on the horizon. First, there are changes in the music department. As you know, Dagny retired this spring. After some prayerful discernment, Deacon Jennifer Fox has decided to take on the leadership of the Spirit Singers as well as the Spirit Ringers. Chris Parkinson will still be present on Sunday mornings and assist with Ringers and Singers as needed, but Deacon Jennifer will lead rehearsals on Wednesday evenings.

Deacon Jennifer has also taken on more responsibilities around pastoral care. She will be visiting members at home and in the hospital, while also co-chairing the newly formed Christ Cares team with Lee Blackburn. Our hope is that this team provides meals, rides, and assistance with small errands for some of our members for whom these tasks are challenging.

The final shift in staff will affect Sunday mornings. Beginning September 7, Pastor Jeff Clements will be an active partner in our ministry each Sunday morning moving forward. He will preside over communion and baptisms, and share preaching responsibilities with Deacon Laura. Additionally, he will teach Adult Forums from time to time and help Deacons Laura and Jennifer with long-term worship planning. This will provide Deacon Laura with support as she continues in her role as Interim Minister. Think of it as “Pulpit-Supply Plus.” Pastor Jeff does not plan on attending council meetings or other committee meetings.
